of my three cats. We arrived at the designated time and found a cemetery full of excavators, pickup trucks and pet owners working on removing their beloved animals from their everlasting home. Conversations with the other owners were full of surprise, outrage, and confusion over the situation.

On the designated day of exhumation, my sister and I arrived at the cemetery bright and early. The digging began and problems arose with all three burial sites. Tree roots had forced their way through the caskets and removal was delicate. Fortunately, the men were very respectful and treated the remains with dignity. They were taken to my designated crematorium and I went home with the burial stones I had placed on the graves so many years before. The next day I picked up the final remains that were placed in personally engraved urns.

There were thousands of pets buried at this cemetery and many burial sites remained intact when the gates were

closed. My heart aches thinking about the hundreds of pets that will be exhumed by construction vehicles preparing the land for community development.
