TOOL TIPS

It is frustrating when using a syringe to administer liquid medicine, and you cannot depress the plunger. This is caused by a vacuum.



To avoid a vacuum, first, draw air into the empty syringe to the medicine's dose level. Then insert the tip of the syringe into the bottle stopper. Depress the plunger

releasing the air into the bottle. Then draw up the medicine to the appropriate dosage mark. No vacuum is created and the plunger depresses with ease.
