Backdoor Friends Purebred Cat Rescue no longer collects shoes to recycle, which we had been doing since 2012.

Why? We were not receiving payment for the boxes we sent, nor receiving responses to our written and phone inquiries. Later it was posted on Facebook that they joined with another company who also collected and redistributed shoes.

Nancy McVicar said, "I looked into the new program and felt it was too restrictive and didn't meet our needs."

She contacted a law firm, specializing in non-profits, for advice and filed a complaint with the State's Attorney General. There has been no further progress to receive payment for shoes sent.

Numerous US cities have banned declawing, but New York is the first state. NY Assembly woman Linda Rosenthal advocated for the anti-declawing bill for five years before it was signed into law in 2019 by Governor Andrew Cuomo. Much of Europe, Canada and 39 nations around the world have outlawed the painful procedure. 🐾
